Overview

The 2.8 release will be pushed to production on March 17th, 2017. Following is a high-level overview of the changes in this release.

New Features

- **Last Name + Postal Address** matching to Household documents

Changes and Improvements

- Corrected Postal endpoint for bundle parameter length

New Features

Last Name + Postal Address matching to Household documents

Data Services API now has the ability to match to household documents based on **Last Name** and **Postal Address** only.

Example

Both of the following requests will return a household document:

- Doe, 123 Main St, 75070
- Jane Doe, 123 Main St, 75070

Impact to clients

- **Transactional:** Household documents can be returned with a Last Name and Address only request
- **Batch:** Household documents can be returned with a Last Name and Address only request

Changes & Improvements

Corrected parameter lengths in Postal endpoint

The issue of parameters being rejected for being “too long” when several are comma delimited has been corrected.

Impact to clients

- **Transactional:** NA
- **Batch:** For a Postal batch request, the bundle parameters will be validated correctly
